

Please find below our most up to date Covid Action Plan Effective 9/27/2021. Please note this **supersedes** any previously communicated information. We have been working with the LA County Department of Public Health and have revised our plan accordingly.

Steps to Take - Student Tests Positive

1. After receiving a positive PCR test for COVID-19 please send confirmation to the school. St. Nicholas School has a partnership with Universal Diagnostic Lab. Universal Diagnostic Lab is located at 6700 Valjean Avenue Van Nuys, CA 91406. www.udlab.com The school will be notified of both positive and negative test results for students testing at this facility. If you test at another facility you **MUST** provide the school with your results.
2. If an individual tests positive, they must quarantine for a minimum of ten days and must be symptom free for three days prior to returning to school.
3. Any close contacts of the individual within 2 days of the positive test will be notified. A close contact is anyone who has been within six feet of the ill person for 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period of time. Health experts agree this only applies indoors.
4. Siblings of the person testing positive will be quarantined for a minimum of ten days and must be symptom free for three days prior to returning to school. If symptoms arise they will need to be tested. After receiving a negative test result they may return to school after ten days.

Steps to Take - Student was identified as a close contact

1. Vaccinated students - Do not need to quarantine. Students must monitor for symptoms over the next seven days.
2. Not Vaccinated Students - Must get a PCR test on day five from exposure. If the test is negative, they can return after seven days.
3. If they do not elect to get a test, they can return after ten days.

Siblings

If a child in your household exhibits any symptoms of Covid-19. Please keep all of your children home. Monitor all children for symptoms. If symptoms arise they will need to be tested. If positive refer to above (student tests positive). After receiving a negative test result on or after day five they may return to school after seven days.
